ALBERT THOMAS BAKER Private 265441. "F" Coy. Ist/1st Battalion,

Hertfordshire Regiment.

Killed in action in France and Flanders on 4th November 1918. Aged 22.

Born in Wigginton. Son of Frederick and Lucy Baker of Red Cottages Wigginton.

Buried: Ghissignies British Cemetery, Nord. France. Grave ref. A.3.

**ARCHIBALD BAKER** Private 24742. "D" Coy, 6<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).

Killed in action France and Flanders on 3rd May 1918. Aged 19.

Born in Wigginton. Son of Frederick and Lucy Baker of Red Cottages Wigginton.

Buried: Mailly Wood Cemetery, Mailly-Maillet Somme, France. Grave ref. II.J.7

WALTER ERNEST BAKER Private 32331. 8th Battalion, East Surrey

Regiment.(Memorial says Middlesex Regiment)

Killed in action France and Flanders on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 1917. Aged 35.

Born in Wigginton. Son of Charles and Phoebe Baker of Wigginton Bottom. Husband of Louisa Alice Baker of Chesham Road, Wigginton. Father of Bertha Baker.

Commemorated : Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France. Bay 6

**GEORGE SAMUEL BALDWIN** Gunner 176326. "C" Battery, 70<sup>th</sup> Brigade. Royal Field Artillery.

Killed in action France and Flanders on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1917.

Lived in Mayfair. Son of George and Elizabeth Baldwin of Heath End.

Commemorated: Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France. Bay 1.

**SYDNEY JAMES BALDWIN** Driver 8842. 29<sup>th</sup> Ammunition Col.,Royal Field Artillery.

Died at sea south of Salonkia Bay. from H.T. Marquette torpedoed on 23<sup>rd</sup> October 1915.

Born in Wigginton. Son of William and Lydia Baldwin of Clay Hill.

Commemorated: Mikra Memorial, Greece

**JOHN BIRCH** Private 42443. Ist Battalion Lincolnshire Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders on 21st March 1918. Aged 19.

born Wigginton. Son of George William and Mary Louise Birch of Pheasant Cottage Wigginton.

Commemorated: Pozieres Memorial, Somme, France. Panel 23 and 24.

**ERNEST BLAKE** Private 3715. 2<sup>nd</sup>/1<sup>st</sup> Bucks Battalion, Lincolnshire Regiment. Died of wounds France and Flanders on 22<sup>nd</sup> April 1916. Aged 21. Lived in Wigginton. Son of George Blake of Wigginton. Buried Hebuterne Military Cemetery, Pas de Calais, France. Grave ref.I.B.1.

**ARTHUR BROWN** Private 96080. 2<sup>nd</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Battalion Sherwood Foresters (Notts and Derby Regiment).

Killed in action France and Flanders on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 1917. Aged 26.

Born Wigginton. Son of Charles and Christina Brown of Chesham Road, Wigginton.

Husband of Sarah Brown of Ivy Cottage, High street, Handy Cross, Sussex.

Commemorated: Cambrai Memorial, Louverval, Nord, France. Panel 8.

MARTIN BUSBY Private 266136. Ist Battalion Hertfordshire Regiment.

Killed in action in France and Flanders 24th January 1918. aged 25.

Born Wigginton. Son of Mr and Mrs R Baker of Wigginton Bottom, Hertfordshire.

Buried : Canada Farm Cemetery, Ieper, West-Viaanderen, Belgium. Grave ref III.G.33.

**FREDERICK WILLIAM DEDMAN** Private R4/095441 Remount Depot, Army Service Corps.

Died of Appendicitis Husley Camp Hospital, England 30<sup>th</sup> December 1915.Aged 35. Born St Pancras. Husband of Gertrude Dedman of Church Row, Wigginton, father of Frederick, Maud, Nora and Lena.

Buried: Netley Military Cemetery, Hampshire Grave ref: C.E. 1771

**JAMES DELDERFIELD** Private 20027 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment.

Transferred to (601505) 142<sup>nd</sup> Company Labour Corps.

Died in France and Flanders 26th August 1918. Aged 33.

Born Wigginton. Son of James and Mary Ann Delderfield of Berkhamsted, Husband of Elizabeth Delderfield of 13, Middle Road, Berkhamsted.

Buried: Puchevilliers British Cemetery, Somme, France Grave ref: III.D. 12.

ALBERT EDWARD DELL Corporal 5404 Army Cyclist Corps.

Died of Wounds in France and Franders 3<sup>rd</sup> May 1918. Aged 33.

Born in Wigginton. Husband of Beatrice Dell of Lower Wigginton.

Buried: Hedauville Communal Cemetery Extension, Somme, France. Grave ref: A.10

**BERTIE DELL** 10595 Grenadier Guards. Awarded silver badge 11<sup>th</sup> August 1915 for

wounds received.K.R. 392 XV1. Husband of Lucy Dell, Father of Ethel and Reginald Cecil and Dorothy.

Died 11<sup>th</sup> April 1917 of Gastric Ulcer, prolonged hemorrhage. 1 Gladesmere Road, Tottenham. Aged 32.

**GEORGE DELL** Private 24323 13<sup>th</sup> Battalion East Surrey Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders 30th May 1917. Aged 41

Born Wigginton. Lived Lower Streatham, Surrey. Mrs L Dell applies for late husbands medals May 1927. Church Row. Wigginton.

Commemorated: Gouzeaucourt New British Cemetery, Nord, France.Sp.Mem. A 13

**HORACE OLIVER DWIGHT** Serjeant 266133 Hertfordshire Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders 21st September 1917. Aged 23.

Born Wigginton. Son of Albert and Sarah Dwight, The Bit, wigginton.

Commemorated :Tyne Cot Memorial, Zonnebeke, West-Viaanderen, Belgium Panel 15

**ARTHUR EGGLETON** Private 8687 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Northamptonshire Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders 8<sup>th</sup> July 1916. Aged 29.

Son of Thomas and Annie Eggleton of Wigginton bottom.

Commemorated: Thiepval Memorial, Somme, France. Pier and face 11A and 11D

**WILLIAM FIELD** Corporal 10801 5<sup>th</sup> Battalion Royal Berkshire Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders 20th May 1916. Aged 27.

Born Marylebone. Son of Mrs Mary Birch. Pheasant Cottage. Wigginton.

Commemorated: Loos Memorial, Pas de Calais, France. Panel 93 to 95.

ROBERT FULKS Private 45650 4th Battalion Suffolk Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders 26th September 1917. aged 29

Born Tring. Son of James and Dorcas Fulks of Egremont, Alberta, Canada. Husband of Emma Fulks of Heronsgate, Rickmansworth, Hertfordshire.Family in Fox Road, Wigginton in 1901.

Commemorated : Tyne Cot Memorial, Zonnebeke, West-Viaanderen, Belgium. Panel 40 to 41, and 162 to 162A

**PATRICK GROGAN** Private 95034 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve Brigade,Royal Field Artillery. Died 18<sup>th</sup> June 1918. Aged 33

Son of Mrs and Mrs Paul Grogan of Co. Clare. Ireland. Husband of Edith Mary Grogan (Nee Fulks, sister of Robert Fulks) Egremont, Alberta, Canada. Buried: Luton Church Burial Ground.

**JAMES GURNEY** Private 14225 7<sup>th</sup> Bedfordshire Regiment. Killed in action in France and Flanders 27<sup>th</sup> September 1916. Aged 27 Son of Charles and Eliza Gurney, The Bit, Wigginton. Commemorated: Thiepval Memorial. Somme, France. Pier and face 2C.

MARK GURNEY Private GS/67233 2<sup>nd</sup> London Regiment, Royal Fusiliers.(Memorial says The Buffs )
Died 26/10/1917 France and Flanders. Aged 19
Born Wigginton. Son of Charles and Eliza Gurney, The Bit, Wigginton.

**ARTHUR EDWARD KINGHAM** Private 35628 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion The Buffs (East Kent Regiment)

Died of pneumonia France and Flanders 19th October 1918 Aged 21.

Born in Wigginton. Son of Frederick Kingham, Wigginton.

Buried: Villers-Bretonneux Military Cemetery, Somme, France.

**ARTHUR MEAD** Private 27768 8th Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment.

Killed in action France and Flanders 27th June 1917. Aged 36.

**WALTER ROWE** Private 26340 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion Norfolk Regiment (Memorial says Nottinghamshire Regiment)

Died of wounds France and Flanders 30th November 1917. aged 35.

Born Wigginton. Son of George and Annie Rowe, Husband of Elizabeth Rowe, Wick Road, Wigginton. Father of Laura Rowe.

Buried : Rocquigny-Equancourt Road British Cemetery, manacourt, Somme, France. Grave ref : VI A

**GEORGE HENRY TURNEY** Private 19163 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment. Died of wounds France and Flanders 22<sup>nd</sup> August 1918. Aged 28. Born Wigginton. Son of William and Hannah MariaTurney, Clay Hill. Wigginton. Buried: Daours Communal Cemetery Extension, Somme, France. Grave ref: V.A.19.

**HORACE LAKE** Private 26560 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Bedfordshire Regiment Died of wounds France and Flanders 24<sup>th</sup> November 1916 aged 26 Born Wigginton. Son of George and Elizabeth Lake formerly of Wigginton Bottom. Buried Berles-au-bois Churchyard extention. Pas de Calais, France Grave ref: L 4
